

All Keeping History Above Water: Norfolk 2022 speakers, registrants, volunteers, and staff are required to provide proof of vaccination in order to participate in all conference programs. Participants are considered fully vaccinated by CDC standards two weeks (14 days) after they have completed either the second dose in a two-dose series (e.g. Pfizer, Moderna, Astra Zeneca, or any combination of two) or after a single dose on a one-dose vaccine (ex. Johnson & Johnson). All WHO-approved vaccines and all vaccines authorized or approved by the national health authority of the country where it was administered will be accepted.

Participants should complete their final vaccine by April 30, 2022. Proof of vaccination must be completed using CrowdPass by May 1, 2022. A link to complete the CrowdPass will be provided after you complete your conference registration.

KHAW: Norfolk hosts strongly encourage that participants participate in whatever Booster Program the CDC recommends at the time of the Conference. However, since the CDC recognizes the original vaccine treatment as "fully vaccinated," proof of Booster will not be required.

In accordance with the requirements of the conference venue, all participants will be required to wear a face mask indoors, except while eating or drinking. KHAW: Norfolk participants will also be required to wear a face mask during other indoor conference programs and while traveling on conference-provided transportation. Hosts also ask that conference participants follow CDC guidance for masking considerations while visiting other indoor venues during the conference.

Social distancing will be practiced as best as possible and hand sanitizing stations will be placed in conference sites and venues. Conference registration will be limited to 190 attendees, or half the regular capacity of the Chrysler Museum Theater. Bus tours, however, will fill to capacity.

There will be no exceptions to this policy. We appreciate your understanding.
